- 2. Promote a coordinated development of the Regional Centres by establishing the Regional Centre Alliance;
- 3. Discuss use of the Space for Development Profile and Space Solution Compendium;
- 4. Promote best practices for effective hands-on and distance learning programmes in future of space science and technology education; and
- 5. Discuss status and future updates of education curricula.
