on the Agenda Item 7: National legislation relevant to the peaceful exploration and use of outer space

at the 60th Session of Legal Subcommittee of the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space

Madam Chair,

As a mandate of Indonesia's Space Law No. 21 of 2013, Indonesia is under the process of making 3 (three) Government Regulations on: Space Commercialization; Space Technology Acquisition; and Spaceport development and operation.

Indonesia also contributed on joint report of the status of the national space legislation of countries of the Asia-Pacific Regional Space Agency Forum National Space Legislation Initiative (APRSAF NSLI) that emphasize sharing information on national space law in the spirit of implementing guidelines for the long-term sustainability of outer space activities.
