Moon Village 2045 Reference Concept






URGENT PROBLEMS



- Many Lunar missions planned in future, from many countries/stakeholders will be conducted in close by locations (i.e. South Pole, orbit)
- > Lack of Coordination Mechanism could lead to harmful interference
- Need to Create confidence buildings and foster peaceful cooperation



SOLUTION



- MVA SET UP:
 - GLOBAL EXPERT GROUP on SUSTAINABLE LUNAR ACTIVITIES (GEGSLA)
 - Multi stakeholders:
 - □ Space Agencies/Governments
 - □ Industries,
 - □ Academia,
 - □ Civil society
 - Public
 - **DEFINE/AGREE:**
 - Recommended Framework and Key Elements for Peaceful, and Sustainable Lunar Activities, this will include:
 - Principles
 - □ Key Elements (i.e. information sharing)
 - □ Guidelines, for implementation the key elements
 - (i.e. interoperability, debris mitigation, safe operations, etc)






• STATUS:

- Kick-off held on 25 February
- Monthly Meetings
- > Work will be completed by end 2022

PARTICIPANTS:

- > 38 Members: 12 Space Agencies/Governments, 10 Industry, 10 Academy, 6 Civil Society
- More than 180 Observers, so far
- > More than 50 countries representatives
- Governments are welcome to become members
- Call for Observers and Sponsors open on MVA website
- DELIVERABLES:
 - □ Presented to COPUOS via MVA, draft by end 2021; final by end 2022
 - Recommended Framework and Key Elements for Peaceful, and Sustainable Lunar Activities with Guidelines
 - Proposed creation of an Agenda Item to discuss lunar governance at 65th COPUOS in 2022




