- 3. We are keen in building capacity of our legal professionals in space law and sharing in the discussion on national legislation relevant to the peaceful exploration and use of outer space.
- 4. Kenya is therefore, considering the treaties and principles on space-related activities, as well as the Guidelines on Long-Term Sustainability of Outer Space Activities and global best practices, in the development of its national space legislation.
