Item 12: General exchange of information on non-legally binding United Nations instruments on outer space By (to be informed)

Thank You Madam Chair,

Let me restate our position in this regard that Indonesia associates itself with the statement delivered by Permanent Representative of Morocco on behalf of Group of 77 and China.

Indonesia supports the exchange of information on non-legally binding UN instruments on space activities in complementing and supporting existing UN space treaties.

Indonesia also is of the view that the adopted guidelines on space activities that have been produced by UNCOPUOS should continue to be implemented as part and parcel of a non-legally binding United Nations instruments on outer space, which, if widely implemented, will become international customary law and guarantee the achievement of the sustainability of outer space activities.
