- Upon submitting statements for interpretation purposes, delegations are to inform the secretariat as to whether the statement may be uploaded to the website.
- Delivery of pre-recorded statements is possible. Technical Requirements for pre-recorded statements - on session website.



List of speakers

- Inscriptions to the list of speakers per agenda item by 27 March 2024
- With the exception of the item on GEV, all agenda items are to be considered in sequential order.
- As soon as discussion on an item has been concluded, the following item will be taken up, time permitting.
- Representatives of member States are to be given the opportunity to speak first under an agenda item, and only afterwards should the floor be given to representatives of observer organizations.

Technical presentations
