# STATEMENT BY AARTI HOLLA-MAINI DIRECTOR UNITED NATIONS OFFICE FOR OUTER SPACE AFFAIRS

Chair, Excellencies, distinguished delegates, ladies and gentlemen,

On behalf of the United Nations Office for Outer Space Affairs (UNOOSA), and in my capacity as the newly appointed Director of UNOOSA, it is my distinct honour to welcome you all to the sixty-first session of the Scientific and Technical Subcommittee.

As this is my first Committee meeting, I hope you will allow me to make a few personal remarks. It is now almost 150 days since I and my dear colleague and Senior Advisor (Deputy Director), Driss El Hadani, took up our posts as the new leadership team at UNOOSA. We are here to serve you and bring visibility to the work of COPUOS and UNOOSA, to ensure that space technology, data and services are being leveraged to the maximum extent possible in the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). We look forward to presenting our vision and strategy for the Office to you later today, which we have articulated based on your feedback <u>and</u> conscious of the increasing vulnerability faced by so many around the world due to the consequences of climate change, security concerns and other socio-economic factors, especially in developing nations.

#### Distinguished delegates,

This year marks sixty-five years since the establishment of COPUOS as the permanent committee of the General Assembly. Over those six decades, the Committee and its Subcommittees have played a critical role in advancing conditions for space exploration, global governance of outer space activities, international cooperation and strengthened multilateralism in outer space activities.

Space is rising-up on the international agenda and the role of COPUOS has been reaffirmed by the Secretary-General in his Policy brief 7: for all humanity – the future of outer space governance. Now, with the upcoming Summit of the Future in September 2024, you, the Member States, have an opportunity to put space on the agenda of Heads of States and drive awareness of the institutional knowledge that we, the space experts have here in Vienna and in the capitals, so that the importance and relevance of Space, of this Committee and of UNOOSA are strongly reflected in the outcome document of this high-level summit, being the Pact for the Future.

#### Distinguished delegates,

As the Director of UNOOSA, I'm cognisant of the fact that we are the only part of the United Nations with a mandate entirely dedicated to space. As such, we carry the responsibility of ensuring that every UN Member State is equipped with the knowledge they need to contribute to and benefit from space technology, data, and services.

In December, we launched the UNOOSA Space Bridge (the USB). The aim of the UNOOSA Space Bridge is to promote global dialogue to enable local action, through targeted exchanges that enhance international expertise and break down silos. Through the USB, we aim to engage a variety of stakeholders to ask the right questions and identify solutions that empower policymakers to advance space sustainability and leverage space for the SDGs.

Chair, Distinguished delegates,

Our responsibilities continue to be closely linked to the work of the UN Secretary-General with the Secretary-General's Bulletin ST/SGB/2020/1 that provides the administrative setting for our role as the gateway to space in the United Nations system, a capacity-builder, a convener, and a facilitator of international cooperation in the peaceful uses of outer space.

You will find highlights of activities and actions for the year 2023, and a number of planned activities for the year 2024 in the Annex to this statement on the STSC homepage. Let me highlight some of the success stories of our work over the last year.

As COPUOS Secretariat, the Office continues to provide substantive, secretariat, organizational and administrative support to the Committee and its subcommittees in their work and assists them in their role as a unique global platform for international cooperation in outer space activities. The Office discharges the responsibilities of the Secretary-General under the UN treaties and principles on outer space, and I am pleased to inform you that as part of the Office's key function of maintaining the UN Register of Objects Launched into Outer Space, UNOOSA has received 2,588 satellite registrations in 2023, a record number for the fifth year running.

In 2023, UNOOSA's Access to Space for All initiative under the Programme on Space Applications continued to enable access to unique opportunities. Working with JAXA, we helped Indonesia deploy a satellite from the International Space Station. We provided access to state-of-the-art research facilities and opened, together with ESA, a new round of applications to conduct hypergravity experiments. We enabled an all-female team from Colombia to conduct microgravity experiments in the 8<sup>th</sup> round of the DropTES programme, and we continued to enable unique educational opportunities through post-graduate fellowships.

The Office's UN-SPIDER programme contributed to satellite data access and coordination efforts during a number of major disaster events in Bangladesh, Ghana, Mozambique, Nepal, Türkiye and Zambia. The team also delivered advisory missions in Africa, Asia, and Latin America as well as to Small-Island States in the Pacific to strengthen their capabilities in disaster management. The UN-SPIDER team also co-launched a joint publication on multi-hazard early warning systems as part of the UN Secretary-General's EW4All initiative and have continued to raise awareness and provide hands-on training on the available space-based emergency response mechanisms.

In its Secretariat roles, the Office continued to support the International Committee on Global Navigation Satellite Systems (ICG) and the Space Mission Planning Advisory Group (SMPAG). We also supported the activities of the International Asteroid Warning Network (IAWN) and the Space and Global Health Network, and organized coordination and capacity-building activities for UN entities as secretariat of UN-Space.

We convened conferences on space law and policy, planetary defence and global health, and conducted events on climate action, space weather, on space technology for socioeconomic benefits, and applications of global navigation satellite systems. We delivered technical advisory missions is space law and policy for countries in Africa, Asia and the Pacific, and Latin America. We implemented projects on Space4Water, Space4Women, Space Law for New Space Actors, Space Sustainability and Registration. We developed the new Space Solutions Compendium (SSC) database to generate information about space projects which can support achievement of the SDGs and the Space2030 Agenda.

Last, but not least, we co-organized with our host country, Austria, the 5<sup>th</sup> World Space Forum on "Space 4 Our Common Future", which brought together a variety of stakeholders to explore the challenges that lie before us — from climate change to sustainability; from development policy to how we communicate about space, and held briefings for Member States both in Vienna and in New York, to highlight the role of the intergovernmental processes in COPUOS. On my first day in the Office, I had the privilege to meet many of you during the annual UNOOSA "Space Camp" Briefing and we will continue with this informative practice in 2024.

#### Chair, Distinguished delegates,

The global challenges we face are huge. They can only be addressed through collaboration and dialogue across borders, sectors, and disciplines. To achieve this, we look forward to presenting you, later today at 1pm, with an outline of our vision and strategy for the office from 2024 to 2030, centred around 5 pillars, which you, the Member States, have conveyed to us during the first 3 months of our tenure. They are Space Sustainability, Space4SDGs, Space4Climate, Space4DevelopingCountries and how to engage the broader space ecosystem on relevant issues and topics. This is a strategy to serve COPUOS as a whole and to serve Member States individually. Just as we have articulated this strategy based on your inputs, we will also need your support and active engagement to implement it as well. Member States remain central to our work, in our service to you as a Committee, as the ultimate decision-makers on space governance matters, and in our quest to help you meet your needs, nationally, regionally and globally.

#### Chair, Distinguished delegates,

Across many of our endeavours, we are greatly appreciative for, and rely on, the support of our partners. Our vision and hope for 2024 is that we emerge with a Pact for the Future that reinforces the role of Space4SDGs, that unequivocally affirms the leading role of COPUOS and that strengthens the role of UNOOSA in helping Member States tackle major global challenges. We have today seen a zero draft where you will see that certain UN entities are called upon to be strengthened. In this regard, we hope you will help us by calling clearly for UNOOSA to be strengthened to deliver on the SDGs and implement our strategy. It is our firm belief that by rallying together around a strong positive agenda with a fresh, structured approach to implementing the peaceful uses of outer space, we can drive transformational change to peoples' lives and deliver on Member States' policy objectives.

I look forward to working with you all as we embark on this journey together in this new year.
