

GSF4D is proposed to be created following the successful example of Global Environment Facility (GEF) administered by UNEP



Global Environment Facility

The Global Environment Facility http://www.thegef.org/, an independently operating financial organization, was established in October 1991 as a \$1 billion pilot program within the World Bank to assist in the protection of the global environment and to promote environmental sustainable development.

Today the GEF is the largest public funder of projects to improve the global environment.

The Global Environment Facility (GEF) unites 183 countries in partnership with international institutions, civil society organizations (CSOs), and the private sector to address global environmental issues while supporting national sustainable development initiatives.

The GEF provides new and additional grants and concessional funding to cover the "incremental" or additional costs associated with transforming a project with national benefits into one with global environmental benefits

GSF4D Objectives

SPACEWAY 2 EMPOWERMENT

- 1. GSF4D will generate funds for general purpose or earmarked for specific purposes
- 2. These funds are to be offered to developing countries by inviting proposals to develop projects **contributing to 4 pillars of UNISPACE+50** GSF4D would be financial mechanism for implementing commitments of UNISPACE+50 leading to implementing Space2030 agenda.
- 3. GSF4D would be <u>financial mechanism for implementing commitments</u> <u>of UNISPACE+50</u> leading to implementing Space2030 agenda.



GSF4D Modus Operandi

- 1. Provision for any legitimate stakeholder to contribute to GSF4D.
- 2. The GSF4D will open up a vast market in developing countries for the space technology solution providers.
- 3. UNOOSA would launch a call to invite proposals from developing countries based on priority areas identified within Space2030.
- 4. Successful proposals would receive full/partial funding through GSF4D.
- 5. The GSF4D should form a corpus for initial project activities and go on tapping into other resources for its further growth to sustain core fund beyond 2030.

GSF4D Fundraising Approach

Goal to generate and launch GSF4D with US \$50 Million Corpus Fund by UNISPACE+50 event

CANEUS proposes to coordinate with UNOOSA the fundraising in Two Phases for Thousand Eyes In The Space

- 1. Phase 1: Initial fund of approximately Ten million USD from CHARTER Members that will help formulate framework to define projects and services offered through GSF4D (STEM, advisory service, capacity, assisting establishing space and ground infrastructure, data centre and other practical areas to assist Member states etc.).
- 2. Phase 2: Worldwide fund raising campaign
