





On 21 November 2015, LAOSAT-1 has been launched from Xichang Satellite Launch Center (XSLC) into orbital slot 128.5°E (GEO).



Coverage Area of C-band transponders






14 C-band transponders of LAOSAT-1 covers Lao PDR and 15 countries in South East Asia




LAOSAT-1 Joint Venture Company

LAOSAT-1 main business services:

1. Direct To Home (DTH) and Television Production Center (TVPC)
Provide 54 sets of SDTV, 2 sets of HDTV, 10 channels of Radio Broadcasting







LAOSAT-1 main business services (continued):

2. Very Small Aperture Terminal (VSAT) provide 70 VSAT of 2.4 m antenna size and 4 sets Satellite Interface Terminal (SIT) of 4.5 m antenna size.







LAOSAT-1 main business services (continued):

3. National Emergency Communication Network (NECN)

Provide 1 set for Ku band hub and 6 sets terminal (3 vehicles and 3 portable)



Legislations and Future Plan

- ■The Ministry of Posts and Telecommunications (MPT) has been issued the Agreement on Satellite Communications No. 2507/MPT, dated 22 August 2016.
- •Since then, we are now updating this Agreement into Decree on Satellite Communications.
- LAOSAT-1 has been registered in the United Nations Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space (UNCOPUOS) as an object launched into outer space since early 2017.
- We have the plan to expand the services of LAOSAT-1 to beside countries and other countries within the coverage areas.
