## **STRENGTHS**

- COPUOS is UNIQUE
- **COPUOS Works!** (e.g., 5 treaties, UNISPACE I, II & III, SPIDER, ICG, space debris mitigation guidelines, guidelines on nuclear power sources, IAWN, SMPAG, LTS, UNISPACE+50)
- Formidable Secretariat
- Decisions made by Consensus
- 84 Member States and increasing
- Includes Scientific, Technical, Legal and Policy





### **WEAKNESSES**

- Decision making is SLOW
- Geopolitical (non-space) tensions
- Decisions made by Consensus
- Weak synergy between Subcommittees
- Commercial sector indirectly involved
- OST@50 under stress
- Governance of space has low priority for global leaders





### **OPPORTUNITIES**

- Increasing membership and interest by States
- Preservation of space for future generations is recognized as being in need of action
- General recognition that space access is ESSENTIAL for delivery of services and the governance of space needs updating
- Support by Member States and UNGA for developing new agenda (UNISPACE+50)
- LTS WG developing non-binding guidelines





### **THREATS**

- Failure of CD to address militarization/ security space issues
- Access to space threatened by space junk and massive number of new planned satellites
- Increase in number of new non-State actors
- Need for new treaty-based governance regime
- Cybersecurity
- Pace of New Space activities
- Unilateral action by a State or non-State actor
