Letter dated 19 June 1962 from the Permanent Representative
of the United States of America addressed to the Acting
Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning United States space launchings. With the deletions to the record contained herein, you will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles and associated objects in orbit or space transit as of 15 May 1962.

In addition, there is enclosed supplemental information concerning the only United States space vehicle which was launched between our previous report (as of 30 April 1962) and 15 May 1962, which failed to achieve orbit. During this period there were no United States space vehicles which achieved orbit but were no longer in orbit as of 1200Z on 15 May 1962.
