Letter dated 1 January 1963 from the Permanent Representative of  
the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions and deletions in the record, you will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all the United States space vehicles and associated objects in orbit or space transit as of 30 November 1962.

The United States launched no vehicles between 16 November and 30 November 1962, which either achieved orbit but were no longer in orbit as of 2400Z 30 November 1962, or which did not achieve orbit.
