INFORMATION FURNISHED IN CONFORMITY WITH GENERAL ASSEMBLY
RESOLUTION 1721 B (XVI) BY STATES LAUNCHING OBJECTS INTO
ORBIT OR BEYOND

Letter dated 29 May 1963 from the Deputy Permanent Representative
of the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

With reference to the provisions of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I have the honor to inform Your Excellency that during the period 16 April through 30 April 1963 no objects were launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. All United States vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 15 April 1963 continued to be in orbit or beyond as of 2400Z on 30 April 1963. Therefore, the information submitted to Your Excellency on United States space launches through 15 April comprises a complete registry of all United States vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 30 April 1963.

In addition there is enclosed supplemental information concerning vehicles launched on 26 April 1963, which did not achieve orbit.
