ORBIT OR BEYOND

Letter dated 27 September 1963 from the Permanent Representative of
the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provisions of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these deletions from the record Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 15 August 1963.

In addition there is included supplemental information concerning a United States space vehicle which was incorrectly reported as launched but as failing to achieve orbit. The vehicle was not intended to achieve orbit and should be deleted from the report.
