Letter dated 29 December 1965 from the Deputy Permanent Representative of  
the United States of America addressed to the Secretary-General

In accordance with the provision of Part B, paragraphs 1 and 2, of United Nations General Assembly resolution 1721 (XVI), I enclose registration data concerning objects launched into orbit or beyond by the United States. With these additions to and this deletion from the record, Your Excellency will have received for the Committee on the Peaceful Uses of Outer Space and for the Public Registry a complete registry of all United States space vehicles in orbit or beyond as of 30 September 1965.

The United States launched no vehicles between 16-30 September 1965 which either achieved orbit but were no longer in orbit as of 2400Z on 30 September 1965, or which did not achieve orbit.
