Corrigendum

Paragraph 16

Add the following new paragraph:

16 (bis) Recognizing the importance of building human solidarity, we urge the promotion of dialogue and cooperation among the world's civilizations and peoples, irrespective of race, disabilities, religion, language, culture and tradition.

Paragraph 17

Add the following new paragraph:

17 (bis) We reaffirm our pledge to place particular focus on, and give priority attention to, the fight against the worldwide conditions that pose severe threats to the sustainable development of our people. Among these conditions are: chronic hunger; malnutrition; foreign occupation; armed conflicts; illicit drug problems; organized crime; corruption; natural disasters; illicit arms trafficking; trafficking in persons; terrorism; intolerance and incitement to racial, ethnic, religious and other hatreds; xenophobia; and endemic, communicable and chronic diseases, in particular HIV/AIDS, malaria and tuberculosis.

Paragraph 22

Add the following new paragraph:

22 (bis) We reaffirm the vital role of the indigenous peoples in sustainable development.

Paragraph 17

In the first sentence, after the word "Sanitation", insert the words "adequate shelter".
