#### Objectives



- Demonstrate the importance of the uses of GNSS technology in the international arena - multilateral, regional and national.
- Underline GNSS support on economic growth and technological capabilities for developing countries.
- Integrate GNSS into the infrastructure and process decision making
- Share GNSS experiences in specifics projects
- Inventory of human and technical capabilities of the region in GNSS
- Establishment of specific pilot projects.
- Identification of focal points of GNSS users in the Region and coordination mechanisms
- Institutional, legal and trade aspects needed for the implementation of GNSS as a national public service



#### **Expected Results**



- Monitoring regional efforts of GNSS, particularly in transport, mapping, training and education in order to share experiences and follow up.
- Definition of specific pilot projects, means, schedule and persons in charge of their development
- Establishment of a set of regional and national Tasks Forces identified for pilot projects.
- Definition of a regional coordination mechanism that could become an interface to the ICG (International Committee of GNSS).
- Best practices on legal and institutional issues for GNSS uses and implementation.
- Data base on the use of the GNSS in the Caribbean and Latin American Region.

  - International cooperation in space technology (OOSA/UN, COPUOS)
  - State of the art for GNSS technologies by Service Providers
  - Regional and International experiences
  - Potential evolution of Regional GNSS Infrastructure in transportation, mapping and education fields.
- 2. Conclusion and recommendations for the plans and projects of GNSS in the Region.

- Bogotá (Colombia). Four day meeting. May 2005.

- Representatives of technical, educational and R&D institutions with decision making capacity in GNSS plans and projects.
- Approximately 100 participants of the Region of the Americas expected.






#### Funding Support
