- (a) Launching State: Federal Republic of Cermany
- (b) Designator: TV-SAT 1
- (c) Date and location of launch: 21 November 1987, Kourou, French Guyana, on an Ariane-2, flight No. 20
 - (d) Orbit: geostationary, position 19° West
- (e) General function of the space object: because of a malfunction of the solar generator, the satellite is being used only for technical tests.
