and Northern Ireland addressed to the Secretary-General

The Permanent Representative of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to inform him, in accordance with article IV of the 1975 Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space, that the United Kingdom-registered space objects:

ARIEL V (formerly UK5), designation 1974-77A, launched on 15 October 1974,

AMPTE-UKS, designation 15201 84-088C, launched on 16 August 1984,

have now decayed and are no longer in Earth orbit. These objects have now been removed from the United Kingdom register.
