The Permanent Mission of Brazil to the United Nations (Vienna) presents its compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and, in accordance with article IV of the Convention on Registration of Objects Launched into Outer Space (General Assembly resolution 3235 (XXIX), annex), has the honour to transmit information on the reorbit of space object Estrela do Sul 1 (EdS-1) on 17 November 2011 (see annex).

Name of space object:	Estrela do Sul 1 (EdS-1)
Date of launch:	10 January 2004
Location of launch:	Sea Launch platform
Launch vehicle:	Zenit-3SL
Owner of object:	Telesat Brasil Capacidade de Satélites Ltda.
Orbital parameters:	The satellite EdS-1 was reorbited on 17 November 2011 and is presently in a disposal orbit, at a perigee of 387 km above the geostationary orbit and an apogee of 482 km above the geostationary orbit.
