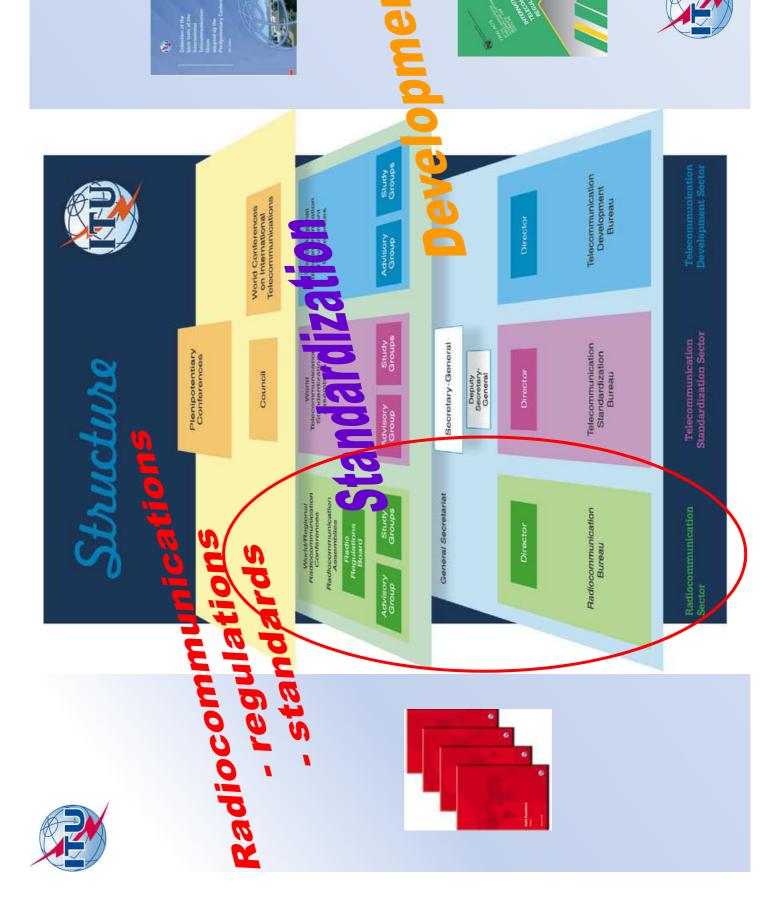

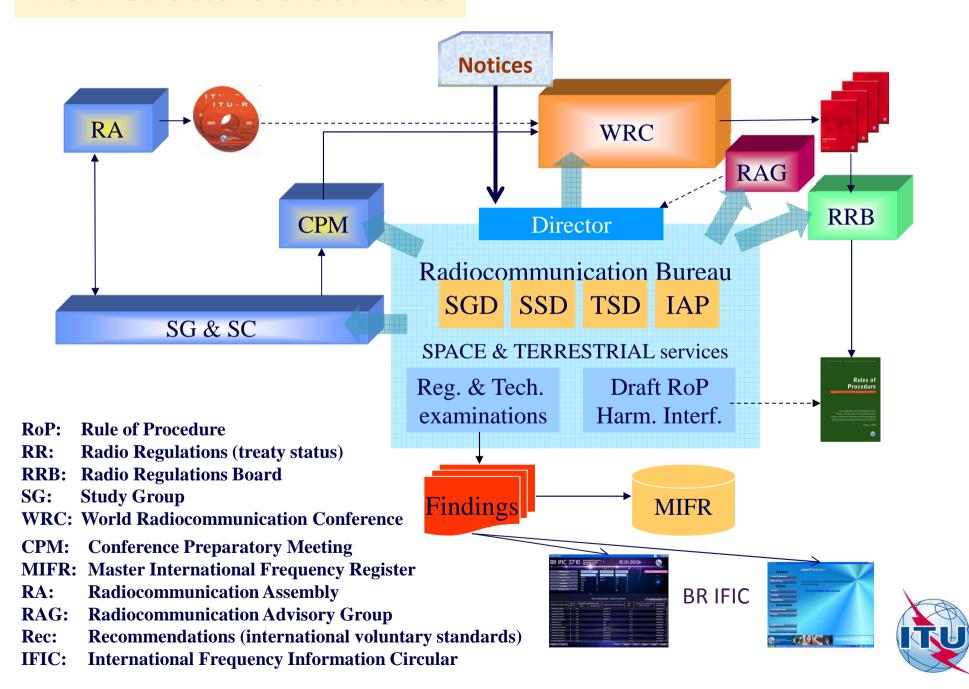

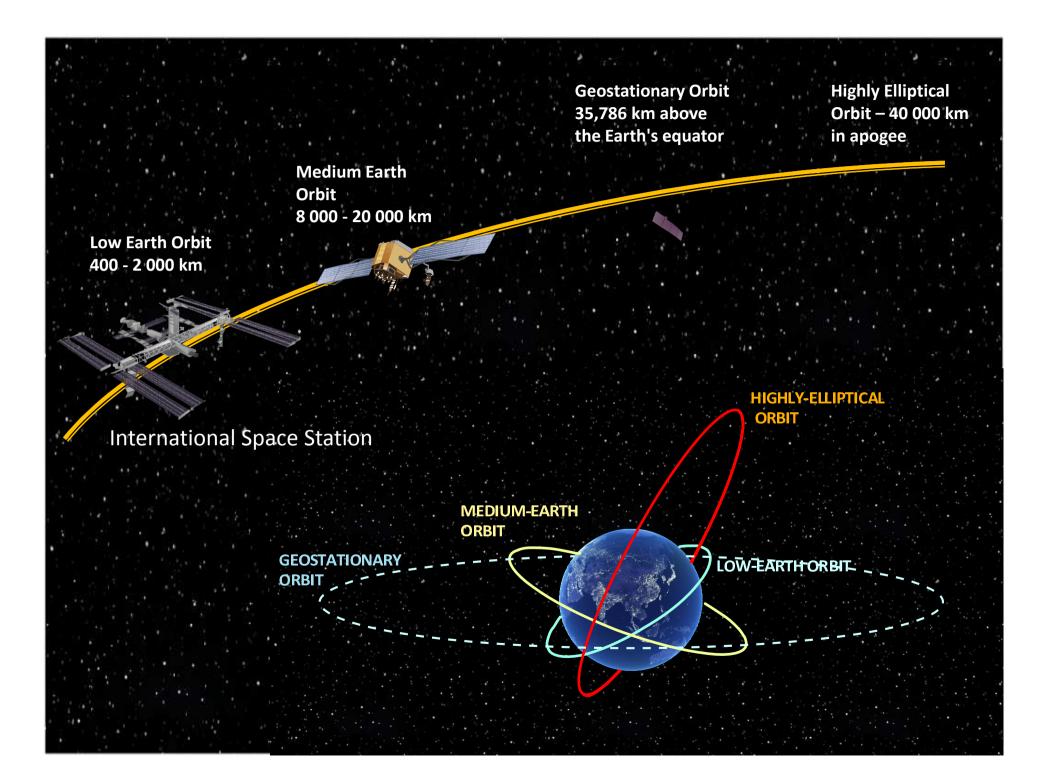
The ITU-R coordinates global wireless communication and technical standards
