

General exchange of views [5]

The Committee continued its consideration of this item with statements by the representatives of Armenia, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Iran (Islamic Republic of), and Mexico.

The observers for the Asia-Pacific Space Cooperation Organization, the International Institute of Space Law, and the Square Kilometre Array Observatory also made statements.
