Programme 5 “Peaceful uses of outer space”: proposed programme plan for the period 2024

1. The proposed programme plan for the period 2024 and programme performance for 2022 of the Programme “Peaceful uses of outer space”, which is implemented by the Office for Outer Space Affairs, is contained in Section A of document A/78/6 (Sect.6) entitled “Proposed programme budget for 2024”.
2. The General Assembly’s subsidiary organ for planning, programming and coordination, the Committee for Programme and Coordination (CPC) is holding its 62nd session from 30 May to 30 June 2023 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York. The formal review of the proposed programme plan for Programme 5 was held 31 May 2023.
3. With a view to providing inputs from the Committee to the programme’s plan prior to the CPC concluding their review, Member States are invited to provide comments to Section A of the document A/78/6 (Sect.6), paras. 6.1 through 6.27.
4. Consideration of the programme plan by the Committee is expected to be taken up on Thursday, 8 June 2023.
