975th meeting

Adoption of the Agenda [1]

Statement by the Chair [2]

Organization of work

The Subcommittee decided to invite the representatives of Côte d'Ivoire, as well as the Sovereign Order of Malta to participate in the session as observers.

The Subcommittee also decided to invite the observers of the International Space Environment Services (ISES) and the International Genetically Engineered Machine Foundation (iGEM) to participate in the session as observers.
