The Permanent Mission of the Islamic Republic of Iran to the United Nations (Vienna) has the honour to transmit, in conformity with paragraph 1 of General Assembly resolution 1721 B (XVI) of 20 December 1961, information for the registration of the KHAYYAM satellite, which was launched into outer space on 9 August 2022 (see annex).¹
